

## Verbo *to be* – Pasado Simple

---

**To be** = ser o estar.

- Afirmativa**

<b>I</b>	<b>was</b>
You	were
<b>He/she/it</b>	<b>was</b>
We	were
You	were
They	were

- Negación (sujeto + verbo + *not*)**

forma completa

**I was not**  
You were not  
**He/she/it was not**

We were not  
You were not  
They were not

forma contraída

**I wasn't**  
you weren't  
**he/she/it wasn't**

we weren't  
you weren't  
they weren't

- Interrogación (verbo + sujeto)**

respuesta breve +

<b>Was I ...?</b>	<b>Yes, I was</b>
Were you...?	Yes, you were
<b>Was he/she/it ....?</b>	<b>Yes, he/she/it was</b>

Were we...?	Yes, we were
Were you....?	Yes, you were
Were they....?	Yes, they were

respuesta breve –

<b>No, I wasn't</b>
No, you weren't
<b>No, he/she/it wasn't</b>

No, we weren't
No, you weren't
No, they weren't

**Ejemplos:** *Were you a student? Yes, I was.*  
*Was she your friend? Yes, she was.*  
*Were they your classmates? No, they weren't.*
